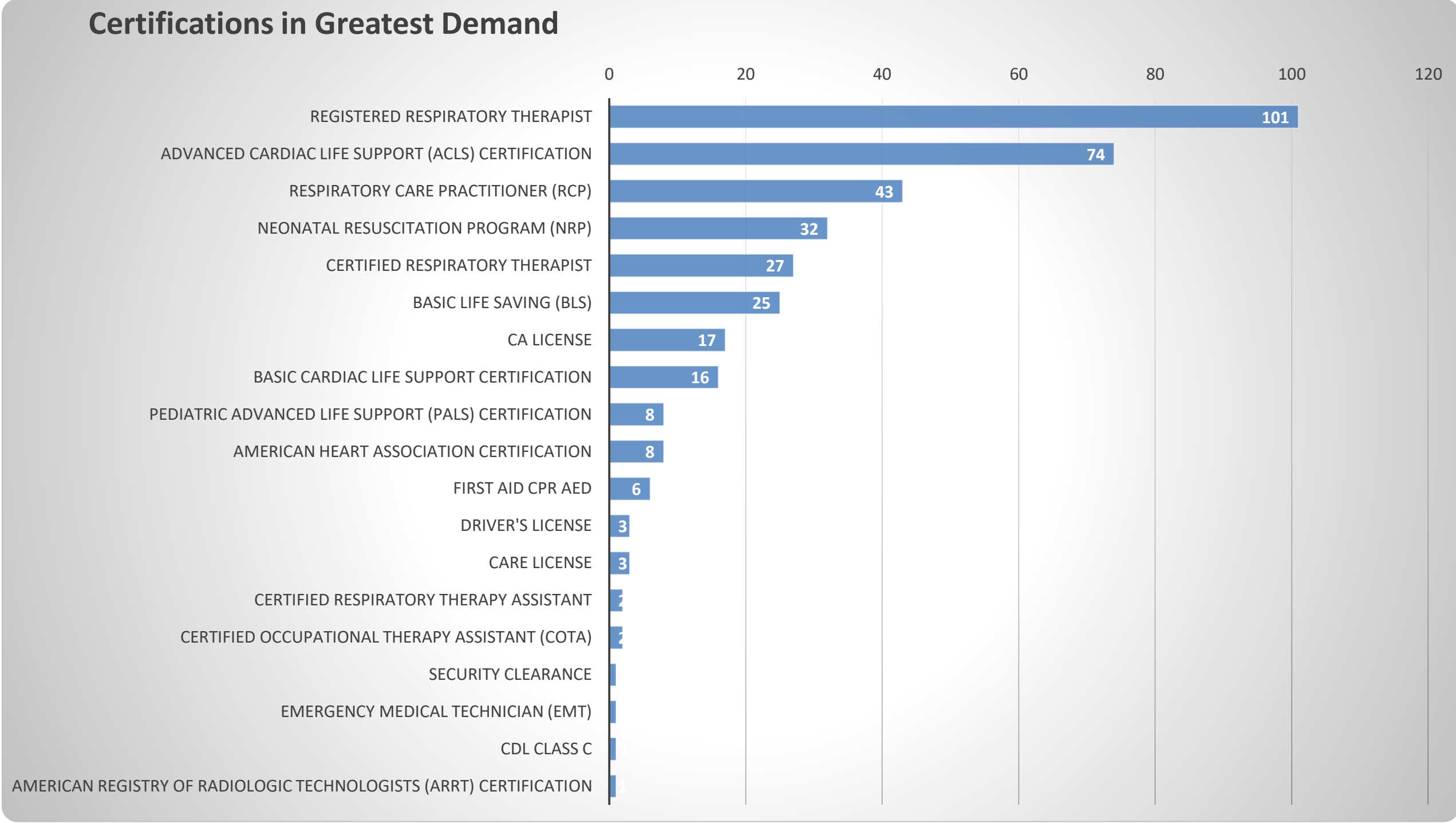
ROLE OF THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR

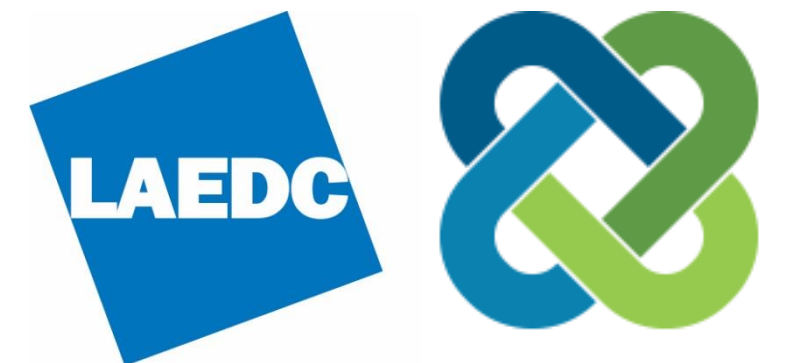
